Mercedes- Lloyd Schwarz, 92, passed away suddenly on Sunday, March 27th, 2022, at Valley Baptist Medical Center in Harlingen.

On December 24th, 1929, Lloyd was born to Ben and Ruth (Imel) Schwarz in Mercedes, Texas. Lloyd grew up in Mercedes, the youngest of six children. Lloyd's father was a farmer, and Lloyd learned the value of a hard day's work when he was a child.

After graduating from high school, Lloyd served in the US Army, stationed in Germany. When Lloyd returned home, he knew what he wanted to do with his life. His passion had always been farming, so Lloyd made that dream come true. Lloyd spent most of his life outside on the farm, working from sunrise to sunset, but he loved every minute.
