On August 19, 1953, Francisco was born to Pedro and Celia (Salazar) Guerra in Weslaco, Texas. Francisco grew up in Weslaco, and as many families did back then, he migrated up North to work, even after graduating from high school. During one of these work trips, Francisco met his soulmate, Arcelia Morales.

They were working at Maple Leaf Farms, a duck farm in Indiana and have been inseparable since they met. Francisco and Arcelia were married at San Martin de Porres Catholic Church in Weslaco in 1979. Francisco was a great provider. He worked at Maverick Market in Donna for over twenty years.

After countless hours and late nights learning the industry, Francisco decided to open Red Ant Mart in 1997, which he successfully managed for twenty four years.
