Harlingen: Homero Garcia, 55, passed away at his home on Monday, January 18th, 2021.

Homero was born on December 25th, 1965; the best Christmas present to his parents, Pablo and Minerva Garcia, of Harlingen, Texas. Homero grew up in Harlingen, where he excelled in football. He was named the Coakley Junior High Football Hero and played all four years of high school for the Harlingen Cardinals.

Homero was determined to become a United States Marine from the time he was a young child, so he enlisted as soon as he graduated high school. Homero was very bright and could master a trade very quickly. He reached to be Legal Chief in his beloved Marines in his four-year term.

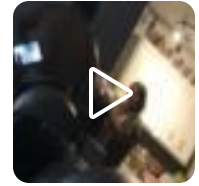
