**W**eslaco- Natividad Treviño, 76, passed away on Sunday, July 19th, 2020 at McAllen Medical Center. She was born on November 3, 1943 to Gervacio and Paulita Valdez in Rancho Buenos Aires, Tamaulipas, Mexico. Natividad was the oldest of seven children.
