He grew up in Edinburg, with his brother, Federico Jr. Ricardo joined the U.S. Airforce shortly after high school, where he served during the Vietnam War. After a few years working in different industries, Ricardo became a Deputy Sheriff for Hidalgo County where he worked seven years.
