Jesse was born on July 1st, 1958 to Jose and Maria Fernandez. Jesse was the sixth of seven boys. He was raised in Mercedes where he graduated high school. Soon after high school, Jesse would marry his high school sweetheart, Angie, whom God had strategically placed in his life, and they would spend the rest of their lives together.

Jesse had started college on a path to becoming an electrical engineer, but God had other plans. Jesse felt a strong calling into ministry, so he attended Bethel Bible Institute in Pharr, Texas and later graduated from Southwestern Assemblies of God University in Waxahachie. He became an ordained minister for the Assemblies of God and was an associate pastor at Bethel Assemblies of God Church in Pharr.
