Following graduation, she returned to Rio Hondo, Texas where she worked in the family's store and served hot meals at the lunch counter to men working in the packing shed. While attending school in Rio Hondo, Margaret met Glenn C. Housley. The two married on May 31st, 1946 in Raymondville, Texas. Margaret and Glenn traveled extensively early in their marriage as Glenn managed crews for produce companies. She went everywhere with him! Their family grew in 1947, with their first born daughter, Claudia Joe. The following year, Donnie Glenn was born May 5, 1948 and passed away five days later. Nora Faye was born February, 1957. Margaret was a homemaker. She loved entertaining in her home and
